Kelly was a competitive Scottish Highland and Irish dancer.

Ms. Duley has been playing both violin and piano for over 30 years, and has been teaching in San Diego for the past 15 years. She is a graduate of Cal Poly San Luis Obispo where she started her path teaching music. Ms. Duley teaches the very young (ages 4+) and people in their 70's, in both classical and contemporary styles. She develops lessons around the fundamentals of rhythm, phrasing, technique (how to sound like a well-developed musician), theory, and ear-training. Her students learn to read music while they also learn to play their instrument. She also encourages and provides opportunities for ensemble playing and teaches practices skills. Her teaching goals are 3 fold: That her students develop musicality and express it in their playing, that they learn to play songs and improvise, and that they have fun along the way. She wants her students to enjoy the learning process and hopes to instill a confidence in them through mastery of their instrument. Ms. Duley teaches a number a methods and styles, including Suzuki, O'Connor, and Celtic fiddle.
